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You are about to purchase a product that is not simple and may be difficult to understand.

What is the product?

Type Debt instrument in bearer form, evidenced in the form of uncertificated book-entry securities, governed by Swiss law.

Objectives The objective of this product is to provide you with the possibility to gain exposure to the performance of the Underlying (Delectus). It has a fixed term and will be due on the Maturity Date. You will receive a cash amount on the Maturity Date which corresponds to the sum of the Reference Prices of the Underlying Components on the Valuation Date, each multiplied by the respective number of the component in the basket; such amount in total multiplied by the Ratio.

You will make a loss if such cash amount is below the purchase price of the product.

All payments will be made in the Product Currency.

The Underlying is a basket of financial instruments which, subject to corporate actions with regard to basket components, remains unchanged in principle during the term of the product. Components of the basket and their weightings are:

The Issuer is entitled to terminate the product with immediate effect, if an extraordinary event occurs. Examples of extraordinary events include the delisting or cessation of an Underlying, changes in legislation, tax events. What are the risks and what could I get in return?

Risk Indicator



The risk indicator assumes you keep the product until 30 August 2021. The actual risk can vary significantly if you cash in at an early stage and you may get back less.

The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the product will lose money because of movements in the markets or because the Issuer is not able to pay you.

We have classified this product as 4 out of 7, which is a medium risk class. This rates the potential losses from future performance at a medium level, and poor market conditions are very unlikely to impact the capacity of the Issuer to pay you. **To the extent the currency of the country in which you purchase this product or the account to which payments on this product are credited differs from the product currency, please be aware of the currency risk. You will receive payments in a different currency, so the final return you will get depend on the exchange rate between the two currencies.** This risk is

not considered in the indicator shown above. This product does not include any protection from future market performance so you could lose some or all of your investment. If the Issuer is not able to pay you what is owed, you could lose your entire investment.

What happens if Bank Vontobel AG is unable to pay out?

You are exposed to the risk that the Issuer might be unable to fulfil its obligations in respect of the product – e.g. in the event of insolvency (inability to pay / over-indebtedness) or an administrative order of resolution measures. In case of a crisis of the Issuer such an order can also be issued by a resolution authority in the run-up of an insolvency proceeding. Thereby the resolution authority has extensive intervention powers. Among other things, it can reduce rights of the investors to zero, terminate the product or convert it into shares of the Issuer and suspend rights of the investors.

A total loss of your capital invested is possible. The product is a debt instrument and as such is not covered by any deposit protection scheme.

What are the costs?

Costs over time

How long should I hold it and can I take money out early?

Recommended Holding Period: until 30 August 2021 (maturity)
